POSTAL VOTING: EASY AND IMPORTANT

The AK elections in Vienna will take place from 10-23 April 2024.

WHAT EXACTLY AM I VOTING FOR?

As an AK member, every five years you can elect the political representatives in your federal province – picture it as an "employee parliament". This means that the members can help to shape the AK's agenda over the next five years. And by casting your vote for a stronger Chamber of Labour, you are also standing up for your own rights as an employee.

WHY SHOULD I VOTE?

As your representative body, the AK is committed to ensuring social justice in the workplace. From employee protection and combating unemployment to vocational training: the AK is with you every step of the way. You should talk to your colleagues about the AK elections, too. Because every vote counts and helps to protect you as an employee.

HOW CAN I VOTE?

Ideally, all AK members should be able to vote at their place of work. If you can't, don't worry: postal voting is also quite easy.

You will receive your voting card with a step-by-step guide by post from 29 March 2024 onwards. Fill out the card and send it back as soon as you can. Alternatively, you can vote in person at one of the many public polling stations.

AM I ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

If you are in employment or working as a freelancer as of 3 January 2024, you are automatically eligible to vote.

If you are an apprentice, working in a mini-job ('geringfügig beschäftigt'), on unpaid leave, or are on national or civilian national service as of 3 January 2024, or if you became unemployed during the past 12 months, you can apply to be included on the electoral register. You will receive information on how to do this in good time from the AK Election Office.

WHAT DATES DO I NEED TO KEEP IN MIND?

- Delivery of voting cards: 29 March 2024 onwards
- Return of voting cards: as soon as possible after receipt and completion
- Voting at public polling stations: 10-23 April 2024
- Last day for posting voting cards: 23 April 2024 (postmark)
